The Moravian Pottery and Tile Works is maintained as a "working museum" where handmade tiles are still produced in a manner similar to that developed by the pottery's founder, Henry Chapman Mercer (1856-1930). Witness the unique tile making process from the raw clay to the finished glazed product, developed over a century ago and emulated by many tile makers to this day.
