



ART TILE COLORING BOOK PROJECT

In support of the Ceramic Tile Education Foundation (CTEF) & Tile Heritage Foundation (THF), the National Tile Contractors Association (NTCA) is calling all artists to assist in creating an ART TILE Coloring Book

We are looking for tiles that can easily be converted to line art which will be enjoyable to color. The invitation is extended to art tile studios through THF and TCNA members to submit an art tile image that we will convert to colorable line art. In addition to creating a fun and relaxing fundraiser for CTEF/THF, the book will serve to educate the industry – and the public – about the bounty of Made in the USA Art Tiles, and the beauty available through these gorgeous and functional works of art.

Submission criteria:

- Send one image per studio/artist.
- Image should be photographed on a white blank background.
- High resolution image (300 dpi at 7" W x 9" H) that will make a clear conversion to line art and that may be used in color in part of the book.
- Tiles should have interesting, but uncomplicated design that will convert well to line art. (See examples on Page 2 for what level of intricacy is acceptable and what is too much.)
- Short description of the tile/line and studio with URL.
- Statement of permission to use stated tile design.
- Only 24-32 will be selected for this first project, but we will keep all tiles submitted on file for future projects.
- All images and accompanying copy must be sent to lesley@tile-assn.com and received by **August 31** 2020.

We're targeting this book to come out Novemberish to have it available for holiday gift giving.
